District Special Education Services

Special Education services are available to students residing within the school district that have been evaluated and identified as eligible for special education services per the Individuals with Disabilities Education Act.

Early Childhood classroom is available for eligible students aged 3-5 each morning and afternoon.

Special Education Evaluations & Related Services

Students referred for a special education evaluation are evaluated within sixty days of parental consent to the school district. The special education evaluation team consists of a School Psychologist, Special Education teacher, General Education teacher, as well as other service providers deemed necessary to complete evaluations during the Identification of Needed Assessments. Additional team members may include: School Social Worker, Occupational Therapist, Physical Therapist, Speech Language Pathologist, Audiologist, Visual Needs Instructor, and Nurse.

The district provides students that currently receive IEP services with Related Services and/or Special Transportation as documented in their Individual Education Plan.

Students who require therapeutic off-campus special education placements as outlined in their Individual Education Plan receive educational services at special education placements, such as the Wabash Ohio Valley Special Education District Annex or Brownsville Attendance Center.
